Internship during vacation for students of Mechanical Sciences, Electrical Sciences, Computer and Information Sciences during vacation of the academic year 2016-17

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 19.01.2017 (copy enclosed) between Karnataka German Technical Training Institute (KGTTI), Govt ITI campus, MSK Mill Road, Kalaburagi and PDACE, Kalaburagi for training engineering students and conducting skill development courses in the following technical areas, presently :

- 1) CAD/CAM/CNC Labs
- 2) Electrical Lab
- 3) Hardware and Networking Labs
- 4) Welding Lab

Further, more courses are expected to be added in future. ~~Overall objective is to provide on-site advanced technology hands-on training to the students of~~ PDACE, Kalaburagi. Course fees are approved by Govt. of Karnataka. (Details are available in page 3 of MoU enclosed). Students can plan to take up 1 month or 2 months courses during vacation between even and odd semesters, corresponding to the coverage of elements of the concerned subject and Lab from 3rd and 4th semester onwards. After 8th semester, they can plan to take up courses which require more than 2 months.

It is observed that in interviews for jobs or for higher studies, immediate question will be number of internships done by the candidate during B E Course with proof.

Certificates are given by KGTTI, an institute established by Govt. of Karnataka under funding from Govt. of India and Govt. of Karnataka and having technical collaboration with German International services. **Students are hereby informed to take full advantage of the same.**



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this 19th day of January, 2017 between **Karnataka German Technical Training Institute (KGTTI)**, an institute under Society for Karnataka German Multi Skill Development Center (KGMSDC), established by Government of Karnataka, under funding from Government of India & Government of Karnataka, and having Technical Collaboration with German International Services (GIZ-IS), having its office at COE Building, Govt. ITI campus, MSK mill road, Kalaburagi - 585101, India (hereinafter referred to as **KGTTI**), on the one part.

AND

Pooja Doddappa Appa College of Engineering, Kalaburagi, an autonomous institution founded by Hyderabad Karnataka Education (HKE) society in 1958 and having its premises at Aiwan-E-Shahi Area, Gulbarga, Karnataka 585102, (hereinafter referred to as **PDACE**), on the second part.

This MoU is made for training engineering students and conducting skill development programs mentored by PDACE in the following technical areas.

- 1) CAD/CAM/CNC Labs
- 2) Electrical Lab
- 3) Hardware and Networking Labs
- 4) Welding Lab

In this connection, the following points are agreed upon:

1. Objective

The overall objective is to provide on-site advanced technology hands-on training to the students of PDACE in the pre-designed course, and support students on a continual basis in order to make them industry ready.

2. Recitals

- a. KGTTI is an ISO 9001 certified organization providing training and consultancy services in advanced technology areas to students, jobseekers and industry personnel.
- b. PDACE is an engineering college established by HKE society. It houses 11 undergraduate courses, 10 post Graduate courses and 12 Research centers, established in Civil Engg., Electrical & Electronics Engg, Electronics & Communication Engg, Industrial & Production Engg, Mechanical Engg, Electrical Engg., Cement & Ceramic Tech. and Computer Sc. and Engg., Information Science, Electronics & Instrumentation, Automobile Engineering, Mathematics and

KGTTI will certify the participants of training programs after successful completion.

5. General Agreements

Both the parties agree that no action / failure on either part, to act relating to the above proposal, will give raise to / serve as the basis for any claim, obligation or liability on either side.

The students of PDACE will take full care of the lab equipment, on the event of any damage / misuse of the equipment PDACE will Replace / Repair the equipment.

This Agreement may be amended with the prior written consent of both the parties.

Either party can cancel or terminate this Agreement unilaterally (and without reason), by giving an advance notice of three (3) months to the other party.

This agreement will be effective for 1 year with effect from the date of signing. The period can be extended on mutual agreement.

6. Course Deliverables:

The courses that could be offered from the KGTTI for engineering students and the suggested batch size along with course fee are furnished below. The training requirement of skill development mentored by PDACE will be discussed based on the need. The course fees are approved by Govt. of Karnataka.
